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| Bell Avenue Elementary School | MOSS | Support students to attend Mendocino Outdoor Science School. |
| Brothers on the Rise | Trail Brothers - Standing Tall and Proud | Redwood field trips to local parks for low-income urban male youth of color so they can connect to their natural environment. |
| Camp Common Ground | Summer Camp | Week summer camp for low-income youth at Alliance Redwoods in Sonoma. Focus on leadership building, social-emotional and cultural relevancy. |
| Civicorps | Civicorps' 2023 Spring Camping and Wilderness Exploration Trip | Supports a camping trip to Humboldt Redwoods State Park for youth ages 18-26 who are in careers towards conservation. |
| Exploring New Horizons | Outdoor Educational Equity in the Redwood Forest | Provide students an overnight science camp where they focus on environmental stewardship, social emotional learning and the arts. |
