THIS IS CONSISTENT WITH THE LEAGUE'S OBJECTIVE TO MAINTAIN THE PURCHASING POWER OF THE ENDOWMENT ASSETS HELD IN PERPETUITY OR FOR A SPECIFIED TERM AS WELL AS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REAL GROWTH THROUGH NEW GIFTS AND INVESTMENT RETURN. THE ENDOWMENT OF THE LEAGUE IS CURRENTLY IN A BUILDING STAGE AND THE BOARD BELIEVES THAT THERE IS NOT A SUFFICIENT BASE FROM WHICH TO SPEND OR APPROPRIATE THE ENDOWMENT AT THIS TIME. AS A RESULT, THERE WAS NO APPROPRIATION FOR SPENDING IN 2025.
